

DEVELOPMENTAL TASKS FOR PHONOLOGICAL AWARENESS

Segmentation	Task
Sentences	Can you say a sentence and clap each time you say a word? <u>My cat is big.</u>
Compound Words	Can you clap one time for each little word? <u>backpack</u>
Syllables	Can you clap for each part of the word? <u>Atlanta</u>
Phonemes	Can you say each sound in the word? <u>Mop /m/ /o/ /p/</u>
Rhyming	Task
Discrimination	Do mat and cat rhyme? <u>Map and mop?</u>
Production	Tell me a word that rhymes with <u>bit.</u>
Isolation	Task
Initial	Tell me the first sound in the word <u>tent.</u>
Final	Tell me the last sound in <u>truck.</u>
Medial	Tell me the middle sound in the word <u>mat.</u>
Deletion	Task
Compounds/Syllables	Say <u>blackboard.</u> Now say it again without the <u>black.</u>
Phonemes	Say <u>tan.</u> Now say it again but don't say the /t/ an.
Substitution	Task
Initial	Say <u>pat.</u> Change the /p/ to /h/ <u>hat.</u>
Final	Say <u>man.</u> Change the /n/ to /t/ <u>mat.</u>
Medial	Say <u>look.</u> Change /oo/ to /i/ <u>lick</u>
Blending	Task
Compounds/syllables	I'll say the parts of the words and you will guess what the word is: bun ny
Phonemes	I'll say the sounds of a word and you will guess what the word is: /r/i//g/ /f//a//t/
