

SIX SYLLABLE TYPES CHART

C	vc (short vowel)	Closed Syllable: A closed syllable ususally has a SHORT VOWEL. <i><u>Never followed by an l, r, w, or y</u></i>	<i>Cat – stamp – path – stop</i>
L	c + le	Consonant + le syllable	<i>-ble, -fle, tle, -zle, dle, gle, etc</i>
O	v (long vowel)	Open Syllable:	<i>no – go – we – hi – she – me – he</i>
V	vv	Vowel Team syllable	<i>feet – snow – rain – moon – toe</i>
E	vce	Magic E Syllable	<i>make – like – bone – these – cube</i>
R	vr	R controlled Syllable	<i>car – bird – turn – her – fork</i>
